
School's Design Competition 2024 Winners




BACDC 2025 DINNER & AWARDS

For 2025, the decision was made to host a full Dinner & Awards Ceremony. In addition, the categories have been expanded to six, inclusive of Women in Construction, Architecture, Engineering, Construction (contractors and artisans), Support Services (retail and heavy equipment operators), and Education (Educator/ Instructor). This initiative is meant to celebrate the contribution of the men and women in the Construction and Design Sector. The criteria for categories will include areas such as design excellence, sustainability, functionality, aesthetic appeal and space utilization, and technical merit."

2025 Award Categories

Architecture

Recognises architects whose achievements demonstrate excellent standards for accessibility, aesthetics, function and innovation, which contribute significantly to public welfare.

Engineering

Recognises engineers whose achievements demonstrate sustainable practices such as disaster mitigation, contributing to the general welfare of the project that led to public safety and disaster prevention.

Construction - Principal Contractors

Recognises principal contractors who demonstrate exceptional levels of sustainable practices within the environment that are a significant benefit to public welfare.

Construction - Paraprofessionals

Recognises paraprofessionals who demonstrate high levels of adherence to occupational safety and health guidelines, produce quality work, utilize soft-skills and create sense of well-being etc., within the environment.

Surveyors

Recognises high levels of service as a principal surveyor (i.e. building, land or quantity) on construction projects, ensuring that the successful execution falls in line with the expectations of the senior project leadership.

Support Services - Retail

Recognises support services: Retail companies who provide equipment & tools, rentals, purchases and finish solutions or maintenance services to the construction and design sector.

Education - Instructors

Recognises educators who facilitate and train students in skill-based areas such as masonry, carpentry, drafting, electrical, plumbing, tiling etc, for their significant contribution to the sector.

Women in Construction

Recognises women in construction whose achievements demonstrate excellence in the construction and design sector, coaching and mentoring other women or students for the improvement of the industry.

The awards are open to artisans (i.e. plumbers, masons, electricians, carpenters), contractors, engineers, instructors of skills-based trades, and retail companies (i.e., tools and equipment).
